





PLC Activity Break-Up

Data Collection

Personal and Academic data is collected from the students through Google forms.

Profile Sheet

After proper verification of the data by the student themselves profile sheets are created containing personal, academic, professional and internship details of the candidates .

Resumes

Student resumes are collected and photographs are affixed to them. Resumes and profile sheets are updated when the students upgrades himself/herself with a new acheievement.

Mock Interview and Mock GDs

The Placement Committee with the able guidance and instruction of the Placement Officer organizes Mock GD/PI sessions for the students to brush up their interview skills.

Student Eligibility

Student eligibility is decided by the companies visiting campus.

Pre Placement Training sessions

Companies visiting campus present pre placement training sessions for the students where the students get to know more about the companies visiting campus and simultaneously doubts regarding profiles, opportunities, pay break-up, etc are addressed. The PLC aids the above process.

Pitching

Usually separate profile -wise studen t interest is taken before student data is shared with the companies.


Campus Recruitment Process

Internet of Things: Convenience or Compromise?

National Seminar at SCIT organized by the Placement Committee, for the past 16 years has been an inimitable platform to critically assess the State of IT and related industries, from multitude of dimensions. Over the period of time, National Seminar has become the platform where the best of the IT minds meet, understand and analyze the dynamics of the IT industry for the future.

State of IT'15 focused on Internet of Things, listed by Gartner in their Top 10Strategic Technology Trends - 2015. The 'Internet of Things' (IoT) is the network of physical objects that contains embedded technology to communicate, monitor, sense or interact with multiple environments. IoTismaking devices, internet, people and processes converge in order to make our lives easier. It is aiding in the creation of smart cities and smart environments and hence intends to save time and money in everyaspect.

As the Internet of Things progresses and becomes a part of our day to day lives, the industry willhave to evaluate how a growing base of intelligent objects and equipment can be combined with traditional Internet and IT systems to support breakthrough innovations in operational performance or public service delivery. IoTis also opening real world opportunities and rapidly transforming our communities and societies. It encompasses more than 14 billion devices (thing) today, connected to the Internet which intends to improve business outcomes through the intelligent networked connections. These billions of devices connecting and communicating with each other raises a plethora of security challenges such as ubiquitous data collection and unexpected uses of user data to name a few. Moreover the devices may suffer from various software, firmware or hardware issues, and it is rare to find an IoTdevice that doesn't exhibit at least one critical failing. Now the food for thought is whether the change brought by IoTwill result in lives becoming more convenient or will it result in our security beingcompromised.

In this seminar we focused upon this global phenomenon of IoT creating unprecedented economic opportunities to enhance productivity, sustainability and experiences, and enable the transformation of strategies required for IT services. It also threw some light on why many IT executives expect these business opportunities would force them to integrate devices despite the security risks, when, they are aware and believe that IoTrisks could become the biggest threats to their network.

The seminar helped to broaden the conception of the changes brought about in the industry with the onset of Internet of Things in the present era.
