Research activities

1. International Speaker for a co-hosted panel discussion by SCIT Faculty Member, May 2023.

18. SCIT Faculty Members represent Indo-Singapore Design Thinking collaboration between SIU and Singapore Polytechnic, March 2024.

Symbiosis International (Deemed University) initiated a long-term strategic partnership with Singapore Polytechnic (SP) in various areas such as student exchange, innovation, setting up an Advanced Manufacturing Learning Journey at SIU, commercializing Design thinking projects with industry, etc.

SIU collaborated on the LeX program, which involves 20 of our students and two faculty members joining Singapore Polytechnic students in using design thinking to uncover insights and identify unmet needs of overseas grassroots communities.
