## 8TH Edition of Integrity and Ethics Conclave

---



The Guest Lecture Committee of Symbiosis Centre for Information and Technology organised the 8th Edition of Integrity and Ethics Conclave on December 16, 2023. The theme for this year was 'METAMELD: Crafting the Tapestry of Tech and Humanity'.

The conclave started with the Main Coordinators of the event Urjita and Adrit introducing the theme and the subthemes. Following the introduction, lamp lighting was done by Dr. Abhinata Dahiya, faculty of SCIT to give an auspicious start to the event. Five esteemed speakers Mr. Samir Chabukswar, Ms. Leena Bokil, Ms. Nirali Bhatia, Mr. Pandurang Taware, Mr. Anub George were invited to share their thoughts on embracing a framework of ethics and integrity, harnessing the potential of technology as a force for positive change, empowering humanity while safeguarding the core values that define our collective conscience.

The Keynote Speaker Mr. Samir Chabukswar, CEO and Founder of Yuj Designs talked about global connectivity, work transformation. He said, "Our behaviours are shaped by the technologies we use daily". He further elaborated on the responsible use of the internet and social media. He said, "because of the technological revolution, 210 million people suffer from internet and social media influence." He further talked about digital and sustainable technology and how communication channels have improved significantly.



Mr. Anub George, Writer/Director and brand strategist, taking forward the discussion on “beyond pixels” a sub theme of the ethics and integrity conclave shared his opinion on “Ethos of Virtual Reality”. Third speaker, Ms. Leela Bokul, NASA-Honeywell Space Educator, spoke on Cosmic Conscience, another sub theme of the event. She shared her experience and various learnings with the students.

Ms. Nirali Bhatia, Cyber Psychologist Psychotherapist shed light on Mindware Convergence by speaking about Cyber Bullying, AI and Cyber Psychology. 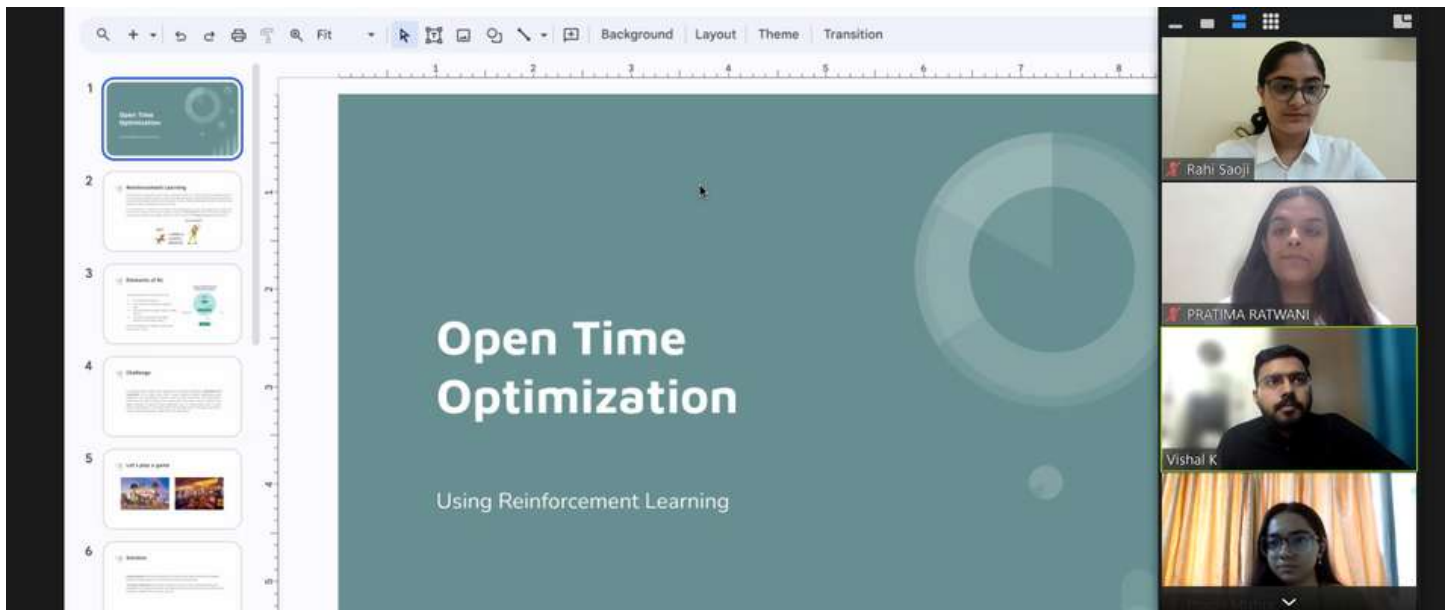

Her constant motivation and calling in life are what she faced, and whatever difficulties she had to go through, from getting a quality education to getting fundamental human rights in society, no one else should meet the same in her community. However, she has completed her MBA and worked in corporate for a few years. She highlighted the need for a more effective implementation of a progressive transgender policy and acceptance of all humankind irrespective of their identity will make it better.

Ms. Deepali Bhagwati is another powerful individual with a double Master's in Genetics. She is now into teaching. Deepali leads the citizenship vertical at IDOBRO- a social enterprise. She excels in project management and CSR initiatives. Deepali beautifully quoted Abdul Kalam- "When there is righteousness in the heart, there is beauty in the character. When there is beauty in the character, there is harmony in the home. When there is harmony in the home, there is order in the nation. When there is order in the nation, there is peace in the world."

# Guest Lecture – Navigating the Challenges of Reinforcement Learning



In a recent guest lecture, Mr. Vishal Kumar, a seasoned Data Science Manager at American Express, delved into the intricacies of reinforcement learning, focusing on the nuances of Open Time optimization and the challenges associated with long-term rewards. Under the guidance of Dr. Ajey Kumar, mentor of the Guest Lecture Committee for the Data Science and Data Analytics division, the lecture provided insights into real-life scenarios; Mr. Vishal Kumar elucidated the significance of distinguishing between exploitation and exploration using a relatable example from the world of casinos.

In a captivating introduction by the Guest Lecture Committee, attendees were welcomed to a thought-provoking guest lecture featuring Mr. Vishal Kumar, where he elucidated the complexities of tackling long-term rewards in reinforcement learning, emphasizing the need for a comprehensive understanding of the trade-off between exploiting known strategies and exploring new possibilities. To address this challenge, he introduced two prominent approaches – greedy decision-making and Thompson sampling. The former involves selecting optimal actions, while the latter incorporates a probabilistic strategy, allowing for a balance between exploration and exploitation.

Transitioning seamlessly from theory to practical application, Kumar presented a compelling problem statement. He outlined the objectives and intricacies of the task, providing insights into the crucial steps of data preparation, data weightage, and updating parameters. The lecture culminated in a demonstration of real-life Python code, showcasing the implementation of the discussed concepts in a tangible and applicable manner.

Mr. Vishal Kumar's expertise in the field and his ability to bridge theoretical concepts with practical applications provided attendees with valuable insights into the world of reinforcement learning. The lecture not only shed light on the challenges of long-term rewards but also equipped the audience with actionable strategies to navigate and overcome them in their own data science endeavors. As the representative from the guest lecture committee, Prachi Mishra provided a closing perspective, leaving the audience inspired and well-equipped to navigate the challenges of reinforcement learning in their data science pursuits.

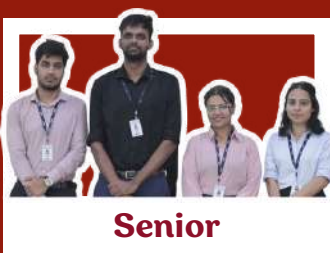
